PROBLEM CAUSING BULLETIN: The expanded metal retainer which holds the foam element from going into the engine failed. On take-off the Cessna 180 seaplane lost power and landed back on the water with no futher incident. Inspection revealed the retainer had broken the welds and had slipped up to the carburetor throat along with the element. This airplane had been heavily used and backfired frequently when starting. We believe this could also happen to others, so we are issuing this mandatory bulletin.

INSPECTION: Before further flight remove element and check retainer. If the retainer is a steel screen, no further inspection is required. If the retainer is aluminum expanded metal and welded to the frame, check retainer for cracks. If none are found, note time in log book and reinspect within each 100 hours use or until P.N. BA-8109A screen gasket is installed, at which time inspection is no longer required. If one crack is found, inspect again at 50 hour intervals until BA-8109A is installed.

COMPLIANCE REQUIRED:

- 1. Order P.N. BA-8109 (Fire Screen Gasket)
- 2. After receiving BA-8109, remove filter assembly and remove existing gasket and discard.
- 3. Carefully install fire screen gasket over airlock pins. Re-install filter assembly airplane.
- 4. Make log book entry.
- 5. No further inspection required.

PROBLEM CAUSING BULLETIN: Cracks have been found in the weld areas where the retainer, (the part that holds the element from going into the engine) is welded onto the frame. To prevent the possibility of the retainer pieces breaking off and going into the carburetor, we are installing a steel screen gasket on all future filter assemblies. This bulletin is to request all users of existing filters with the aluminum retainers to upgrade their filter assemblies by installing the steel screen gasket.

INSPECTION: Before further flight, remove element and check retainer. If the retainer is a steel screen, no further inspection is required. If the retainer is aluminum expanded metal and welded to the frame, check retainer for cracks. If none are found, note time in log book and reinspect within each 100 hours use or until steel screen gasket is installed, at which time inspection is no longer required. If one crack is found, inspect again at 50 hour intervals until screen gasket is installed.

COMPLIANCE REQUIRED:

- Order screen gasket.
- 2. After receiving screen gasket, remove filter assembly and replace existing gasket with screen gasket.
- 3. If retainer is cracked, remove it from frame. This can easily be done with side cutters. File off burrs.
- 4. Reinstall assembly to airplane.
- 5. No further inspection required.

TOBLEM CAUSING BULLETIN: Cracks have been found in the weld areas where the retainer, (the part that holds the element from going into the engine) is welded onto the frame. To prevent the possibility of the retainer pieces breaking off and going into the carburetor, we are installing a steel screen gasket on all future filter assemblies. This bulletin is to request all users of existing filters with the aluminum retainers to upgrade their filter assemblies by installing the steel screen gasket.

INSPECTION: Within the next 25 hours of service, remove element and check retainer with a magnet to determine if the retainer is steel or aluminum. If the retainer is a steel screen, no further inspection is required. If the retainer is aluminum expanded metal and welded to the frame, check retainer for cracks. If none are found, note time in log book and reinspect within each 100 hours use or until steel screen gasket is installed, at which time inspection log is no longer required. FAA AD-78-25-05 requires that the aluminum retainer be replaced before 526 hours of service.

COMPLIANCE INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Order screen gasket.

2. After receiving screen gasket, remove filter assembly. Remove aluminum retainer from frame. This can easily be done with side cutters. File off burrs.

3. Replace existing gasket with screen gasket.

SUBJECT: Loose gaskets

MODELS: BA-100, BA-2310, BA-5710, BA-6210, BA-7110, BA-7210, BA-7310, BA-7410, BA-7510 that were manufactured prior to July 1980. FILTER MODELS:

REASON: Product Improvement. Gaskets have become loose due to oils, grease, fuel, loose and poorly fit fasteners that hold the filter in place. This has been a problem area for years with all brands of filters that use this type gasket.

CHANGE: Brackett Aircraft Co. Inc. is installing gasket retainer strips that will prevent a gasket from entering the induction system in event the gasket should become loose. This is effective on all above models manufactured after June 1980 and on.

RETROFIT: Brackett Aircraft Co. Inc. is making available kits to upgrade existing filter.

COMPLIANCE: Owner's discretion.





Aircraft models involved: All Cessna 180A, 182, 185 and certain Bellanca using PN BA-8110.

Reason for Bulletin:

We have had 3 reports where an airlock fastener has come loose, allowing solvents and oils to loosen the gasket from the screen, allowing possibility of gasket ingestion.

Prior to August of 1981 we manufactured the BA-8110 filter assembly with a gasket on both sides of the backfire screen. August 1981 and after the filter assemblies have been manufactured with the backfire screen riveted inside the assembly and the addition of gasket retainer strips to prevent any chance of the gasket migrating into the induction system. We would like to get all of these older BA-8110's up graded for added safety.

We suggest you inspect at annual or sooner. INPSECTION:


Push the foam element away from either side of the frame and look to see if the screen is riveted into the box. If it To check: is, then it is OK.

Action to take:

If the inspection reveals an affected filter screen (a screen that is sandwiched with two gaskets) then order Kit Part No. BA-81C.

Ordering and Reimbursement procedure:

The list price Order Kit Part No. BA-81C from your parts distributor. is \$7.88. [Install the kit as per instructions. 
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

SCREEN AND GASKET RETAINER KIT BA-81C FOR FILTER ASSEMBLY BA-8110


OBJECTIVE: To replace the existing screen gasket P.N. BA-8109 with a riveted in screen and 2 each gasket retainer strips plus cementing on a new gasket to the frame.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1. Remove filter assembly BA-8110 from aircraft and remove grill and element.
- Step 2. Remove screen gasket P.N. BA-8109 from frame by pulling off over the airloc fasteners and discard.
- Step 3. Clean frame thoroughly.
- Step 4. Install screen P/N 8106-1 into frame with bent edges up.



- Step 5. Insert retainer strips P/N 7105 between the screen and frame.
- Step 6. Start with the open angle end. Diagram (A) Use a 1/8" drill and drill a hole through the screen, the retainer strip and the frame. Next insert a SSD-4-3 rivet through the frame, retainer and screen, and then place a AN 960-6L washer over the rivet and rivet in place. Diagram (B) Next drill the 2 other holes and rivet. See rivet pattern shown in diagram (C) below.



- Step 7. Drill the three holes in the closed angle end from the frame side and rivet retainer and screen in place.
- Step 8. Drill 2 holes in center of the upturned screen sides and rivet in place. Use 2 each AN 960-6L washers over screen.
- Step 9. Install gasket by cementing to frame. Use Dow Corning #732 RTV sealant or an equivalent. Be very careful not to damage gasket when pushing the gasket over the airlocs.
- Step 10. Re-install to aircraft as per original instructions.
